We are now working in Unit 13 of the **Fun**dations® program. During the next 2 weeks, we will be teaching:

Skill	What is it?	How can you help at home?
Double Vowel Syllable (Vowel Teams)	Vowel team syllables have a double vowel (d) combination, two vowels next to one another.  oa – boat - /ō/ ow – snow - /ō/ oe – toe - /ō/  Ex. throw d	<ul> <li>Dictate the word and have your child repeat the word.</li> <li>Have your child tap out the word. Vowel teams get one tap.</li> <li>Have your child spell the word.</li> <li>Example words: yellow, toad, rainbow, roast, charcoal, toaster, tiptoe</li> </ul>

## Did you know?

Reading words with vowel teams may not be as tricky as spelling them. We have taught more than one way to spell the long  $/\bar{o}/$  sound (Ex. home, go, snow ). When you dictate a word that has a long  $/\bar{o}/$  sound, have your child check a resource to determine the correct spelling.
