S COUT d	 Dictate the word and have your child repeat the word. Have your child tap out the word. Vowel teams get one tap. Have your child spell the word. Example words: loud, shout, frown, clown, tower, chowder, scoutmaster, discount

Did you know?

Reading words with vowel teams may not be as tricky as spelling them. When you dictate a word that has the /ou/ sound, have your child check a resource to determine the correct spelling.
