Vowel teams get one tap. <br> - Have your child spell the word. <br> Example words: cue, soup, argue, chew, hoop, igloo, stew, value, mildew, shampoo |

## Did you know?

Reading words with vowel teams may not be as tricky as spelling them. When you dictate a word from this vowel team, have your child check a resource to determine the correct spelling.
