



## Foundations Level 2 - Unit 15

<b>Double Vowel Syllable (Vowel Teams)</b>	<p>Vowel team syllables have a <b>double vowel (d)</b> combination, two vowels next to one another.</p> <p>oo – school - /ü/                      oo – book - /û/                      ou – soup - /ü/                      ue – blue - /ü/                      ue – rescue - /ü/                      ew – chew - /ü/</p> <p>Ex. </p> <p></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dictate the word and have your child repeat the word.</li> <li>• Have your child tap out the word. Vowel teams get one tap.</li> <li>• Have your child spell the word.</li> </ul> <p>Example words: <i>cue, soup, argue, chew, hoop, igloo, stew, value, mildew, shampoo</i></p>

### Did you know?

Reading words with vowel teams may not be as tricky as spelling them. When you dictate a word from this vowel team, have your child check a resource to determine the correct spelling.
