


Fundations Level 2 - Unit 17

Skill	What is it?	How can you help at home?
Consonant –le Syllable	<p>The consonant –le syllable is always used at the end of a multisyllabic word.</p> <p>Ex. </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dictate the word and have your child repeat the word.• Have your child tap out the word.• Have your child spell the word. <p>Example words: <i>dimple, juggle, fumble, beagle, nimble, scribble, handle, staple, needle</i></p>

Did you know?

Knowing the six syllable types will greatly help your child read and spell many words.
