Closed Syllable Exception	There are five exceptions to the closed syllable rule: ild, old, ost, ind, olt. They are exceptions because the vowel has a long sound. Note the closed syllable exceptions in the following sentence: You will find the wild colt by the old post.	 Dictate the word and have your child repeat the word. Have your child tap out the word. The closed syllable exceptions get one tap. Have your child spell the word. Example words: scold, wild, bolt, kind, blind, gold, jolt

Did you know?

• These word families are not always closed syllable exceptions. For example, "lost" has a short vowel sound. Use the context of the sentence to read the word correctly.
